

# Pool Rules & Regulations

- 1) Lifeguards are there for your safety and are expected to enforce the guidelines.
- 2) Swimsuits are required by the Health Department. NO STREET CLOTHES ALLOWED. CUT-OFF'S ARE PROHIBITED and men's/boy's swim trunks MUST have a liner.
- 3) Children *under 12 must be accompanied by a guardian in the pool room* . Adults must accompany all children *under the age of 7 in the water* at all times.
- 4) Wet bathing suits are not allowed outside of the pool room or locker room.
- 5) Lockers are available for rent – the Lonoke Community Center is not responsible for lost or stolen items. We strongly suggest you rent a locker (\$5.00 a month or .50¢ a day).
- 6) Lifejackets are allowed in the pool - Floaties are not allowed in the pool.
- 7) To swim in the deep end a swim test will be administered by the lifeguard on duty. The child MUST be able to swim across the pool and back without assistance.
- 8) Horseplay will not be tolerated. (such as running, wrestling, pushing, dunking, roughhousing, standing on shoulders, etc.)
- 9) WALK ON THE POOL DECK –  
ABSOLUTELY NO RUNNING ALLOWED!
- 10) We are a public facility. Please behave accordingly. Public displays of affection IS NOT TOLERATED.
- 11) Use change areas to change children's diapers.
- 12) No alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, or gum allowed on premises.
- 13) Please potty your children on a regular basis.
- 14) Management reserves the right to remove uncooperative patrons
